The Society has booked accommodation at the Brancaster Activity Centre, Dial House, Harbour Way, Brancaster Staithe, Norfolk, PE31 8BW (<http://www.nationaltrust.org.uk/brancaster-activity-centre/>), for the winter field meeting. The meeting will run from 4.30pm on Fri 1st February until 10am on Mon 4th February 2019. The area surrounding the centre has lots of opportunities to record wintering wildfowl as well as resident songsters.

In addition, our President, the internationally acclaimed wildlife sound recordist Chris Watson will be attending.

The accommodation consists of: 9 dormitory style bedrooms with en-suite facilities. This will be a self-catering field meeting. The cost for the three nights is £120 per person including access to the workshop. To book your place on this extended weekend, please send a deposit of £60 to the Hon Secretary at the address below. Full payment due one month prior to event.

## **Information and Notes**

If you have not been on a WSRS field meeting before I hope the info outlined below is useful.

Brancaster is situated about 5 miles to the east of Hunstanton on the coast road, A149. If you are travelling east from Hunstanton the accommodation is situated to the left of the main road on Harbour Way whose turning is immediately opposite the 'Sailcraft' centre (lots of dinghies at the side of the road).

The weekend is run on a self-catering basis, please bring your own food and drink.

If you require provisions over the weekend there is a Tesco supermarket in Hunstanton.

There is a mini market (Leftley's) a little further along the road (1/2 mile) towards Wells-next-the-sea just by the small group of shops and the garage at the eastern end of the village of Burnham Deepdale, (opposite the small round-towered church).

The Deepdale Cafe (next door to Leftley's) is open from 7:30am – 4:00pm every day including Sunday. The mini-market "Leftley's" is open 7:30am to 6:00pm Monday- Saturday and 8:00am – 5:00pm on Sunday. There is a good selection of pubs and restaurants in the area.
